

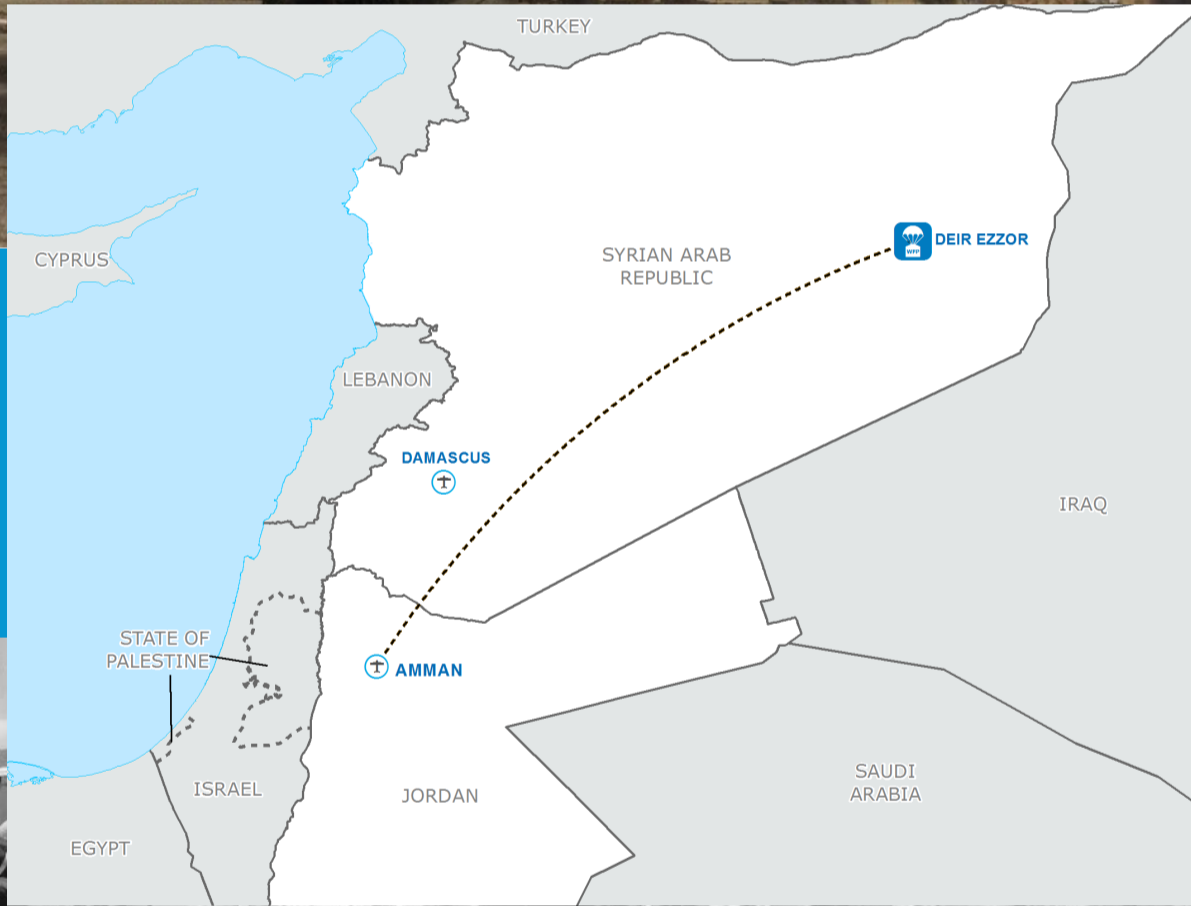

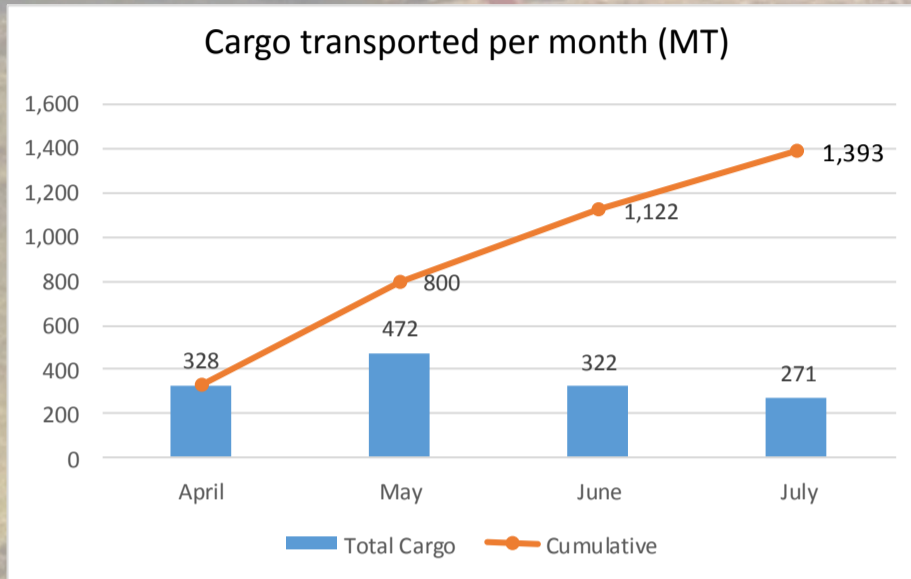

Challenges

- Air operator availability: there is only one civilian certified air operator willing to operate into Syria;
- Equipment availability: equipment is manufactured to order, thereby extending the delivery lead time;
- Intermittent communication between air crew and ground team;
- Special permissions to access, transport, clear and utilize specialized equipment (dropsonds, pyrotechnics, parachutes);
- Actual wind patterns aloft may differ from forecast reports, thereby affecting drop accuracy.
- Overflight permits are granted only for specific periods of time and the renewal process sometimes affects planned schedules.
